CALL FOR BOUTIQUE VENDORS

PAC*SJ Eichler Celebration and Pop Up Shop August 17, 2019 10AM till 2PM

Preservation Action Council of San Jose is hosting a celebration of Eichler's Fairglen homes located between Booksin and Curtner Avenues, San Jose, CA. This enclave of over 200 homes was recently listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Three homes and a 1920's era H.O. gauge train scenario of Santa Clara County's west valley are all within easy walking distance. Ticket prices are \$20 for the general public. We expect to sell out the 500 tickets and heavily publicizing to the mid-century market.

Vendor spaces are limited. Spaces are 10' by 10'. Pop up canopies of the same size may be used by vendors but are not needed on this tree-lined street. The location of the spaces will be **ON THE STREET** which will be closed to vehicular traffic by 8AM. Set up time begins after 8AM. Vendor vehicles must be parked elsewhere before 10AM.
